**Policy Statement**

Fees will be determined by the Principal or by a Senior Officer acting on his authority. In considering the level of fees account will be taken of

- Market forces, including competitor's pricing.
- The relevant team budget.
- The overall College budget.
- Any guidance from the LSC or other relevant funding bodies.

Fees will normally be set to ensure that a contribution to overheads is achieved by the relevant team.
