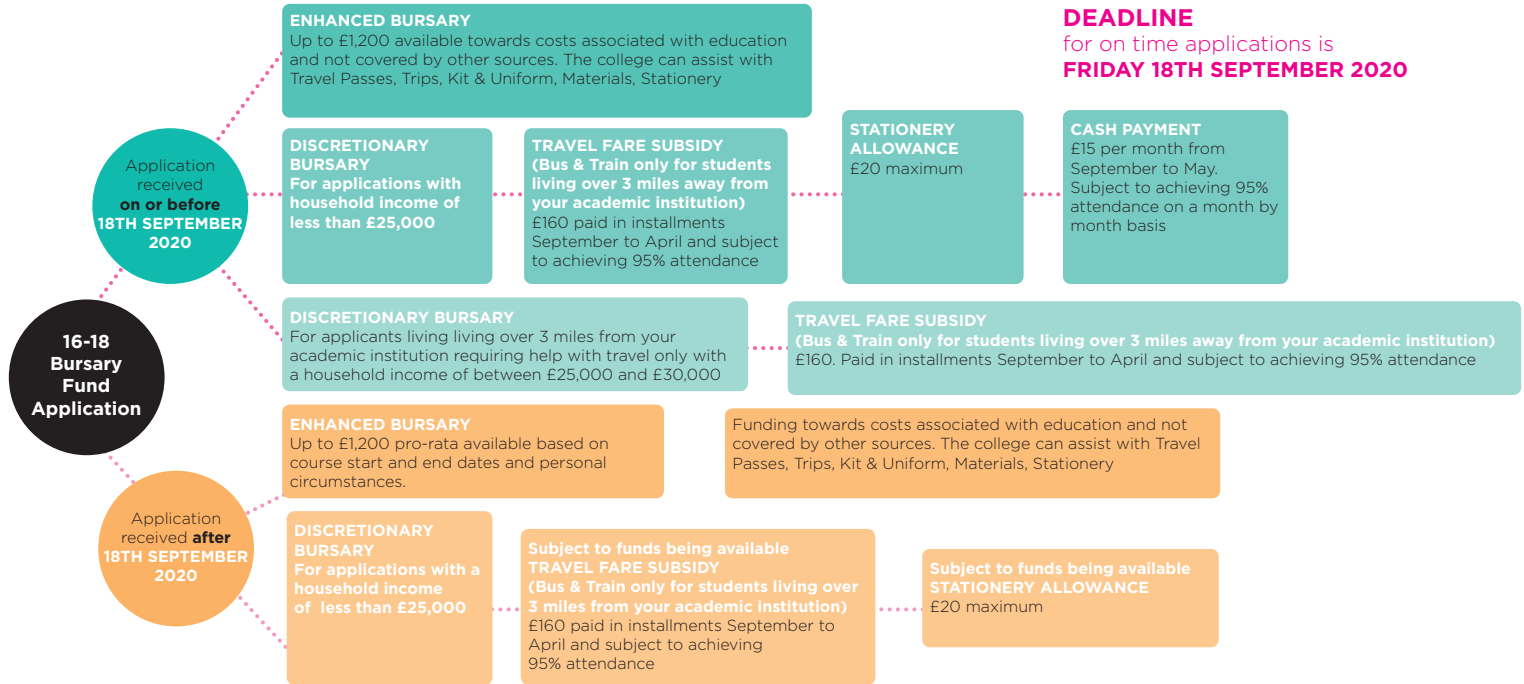
ELIGIBILITY

Enhanced Bursary:

For home students aged 16 to 18 and under 19 as at 31st August 2020 and in the priority groups as defined by the EFA

Discretionary Bursary:

For home students, 16 to 18 and under 19 as at 31st August 2020, in receipt of, or a dependent of someone in receipt of an annual household income of less than £25,000 per year (for travel only annual household income of £30,000 or less)
