An 'Arriva Midland Student Saver Ticket' is available to all ages which can be used throughout the East Midlands on all Arriva buses 24/7 – evenings, weekends, half terms and bank holidays – in addition to your travel to and from College.

For academic year 2019/20, the annual 'Leicester and Derby Zone Plus' pass is £555 for a 12 month bus pass valid from the date of purchase. Arriva do offer 24/7 Student Saver Tickets for other more specific routes and further information can be found on their website.

Kinchcards are available to all ages which allows unlimited travel on Kinchbus between the points chosen including evening, weekends and holidays in addition to your travel to college. Services include the use of the Kinch Sprint Bus to and from the college and the Skylink bus route. For 2020/21 the cost of the Kinchbus Universe is £619 (this can be paid in instalments). There are various cost and route options available – please contact Kinchbus for further information.

Kinchbus are in the process of introducing a mobile solution to a bus pass in the form of a QR code via an app - they hope will be in place for this academic year.
