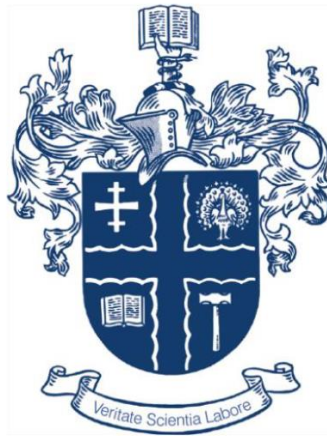

There are four types of scholarships available to internal students progressing onto Degree programmes at Loughborough College.

Scholarship 1 - Internal Student Progression Scholarships

£1,000 payment each year (paid in instalments) for the duration of your programme of study

Available to 2022/23 Level 3 students progressing onto a degree course at Loughborough College in 23/24

Progressing students must achieve 168 UCAS points (A*A*A* at A-Level or D*D*D* at BTEC or an overall Distinction from an Access to HE Programme) and studied this course at Loughborough College.

To receive the first instalment in year 1 (£500 award):

- Student must be enrolled and engaging on a Higher National Diploma, Foundation Degree or Honours Degree programme at Loughborough College in September 2023
- Have a Student Finance England 'Notice of Entitlement'
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Meet the qualification criteria detailed above

To receive the second instalment in year 1 (£500 award) you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have passed all assessments at Level 4 (Higher Education) on your first attempt
- Have a recommendation from the assessment board to progress to Level 5
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Have no outstanding disciplinary, conduct or appeals processes to be completed

Please Note: For students enrolling for a Loughborough College Higher Education part-time programme, the scholarships are pro-rata and normally 50% of a FTE

Scholarship 2 - Internal Student Progression Scholarships

£750 payment each year (paid in instalments) for the duration of your programme of study

Available to 2022/23 Level 3 students progressing onto a degree course at Loughborough College in 23/24.

Progressing students must achieve 112+ UCAS points (A*A* or BBC at A-Level or DMM at BTEC). This scholarship is also available to students progressing from Access to HE with an overall Merit and studied this course at Loughborough College.

To receive the first instalment in year 1 (£375 award):

- Student must be enrolled and engaging on a Higher National Diploma, Foundation Degree or Honours Degree programme at Loughborough College in 2023
- Have a Student Finance England 'Notice of Entitlement'
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Meet the qualification criteria detailed above

To receive the second instalment in year 1 (£375 award) you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have passed all assessments at Level 4 (Higher Education) on your first attempt
- Have a recommendation from the assessment board to progress to Level 5
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Have no outstanding disciplinary, conduct or appeals processes to be completed

Please Note: For students enrolling for a Loughborough College Higher Education Part-Time Programme, the scholarships are pro-rata and normally 50% of a FTE

Scholarship 3 - Internal Student Progression Scholarships

£500 payment each year (paid in instalments) for the duration of your programme of study

Available to 2022/23 Level 3 students progressing onto a degree course at Loughborough College in 23/24.

Progressing students must achieve 80+ UCAS points (CCD at A-Level or MMP at BTEC). This scholarship is also available to students progressing from Access to HE with an overall Pass and both taught blended and advanced apprenticeship programmes. Please note: If the maximum UCAS Tariff points available for your Level 3 qualification is lower than 80 UCAS Tariff points, you will be considered for Scholarship 3. Each application will be reviewed on an individual basis.

To receive the first instalment in year 1 (£250 award):

- Student must be enrolled and engaging on a Higher National Diploma, Foundation Degree or Honours Degree programme at Loughborough College in 2023
- Have a Student Finance England 'Notice of Entitlement'
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Meet the qualification criteria detailed above

To receive the second instalment in year 1 (£250 award) you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have passed all assessments at Level 4 (Higher Education) on your first attempt
- Have a recommendation from the assessment board to progress to Level 5
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Have no outstanding disciplinary, conduct or appeals processes to be completed

Scholarship 4 – The guaranteed Internal Student Progression Scholarships for Part-Time Mature Learners (aged 22 and over)

£250 payment each year for the duration of your programme of study

Available to 2022/23 Level 3 students progressing onto a Part-Time degree course at Loughborough College in 23/24.

This scholarship is also available to students progressing from Access to HE and both taught blended and advanced apprenticeship programmes.

To receive the payment:

- Student must be enrolled and engaging on a part-time Higher National Diploma, Foundation Degree or Honours Degree programme at Loughborough College in 2023
- Have a Student Finance England 'Notice of Entitlement'
- Have no outstanding debt owed to the college
- Meet the criteria detailed above

Guaranteed iPad or Laptop for all Internally Progressing Students

Loughborough College will provide a Laptop or iPad to ALL students internally progressing from a Level 3 course at Loughborough College to studying a full or part-time degree level Programme for their individual use.
