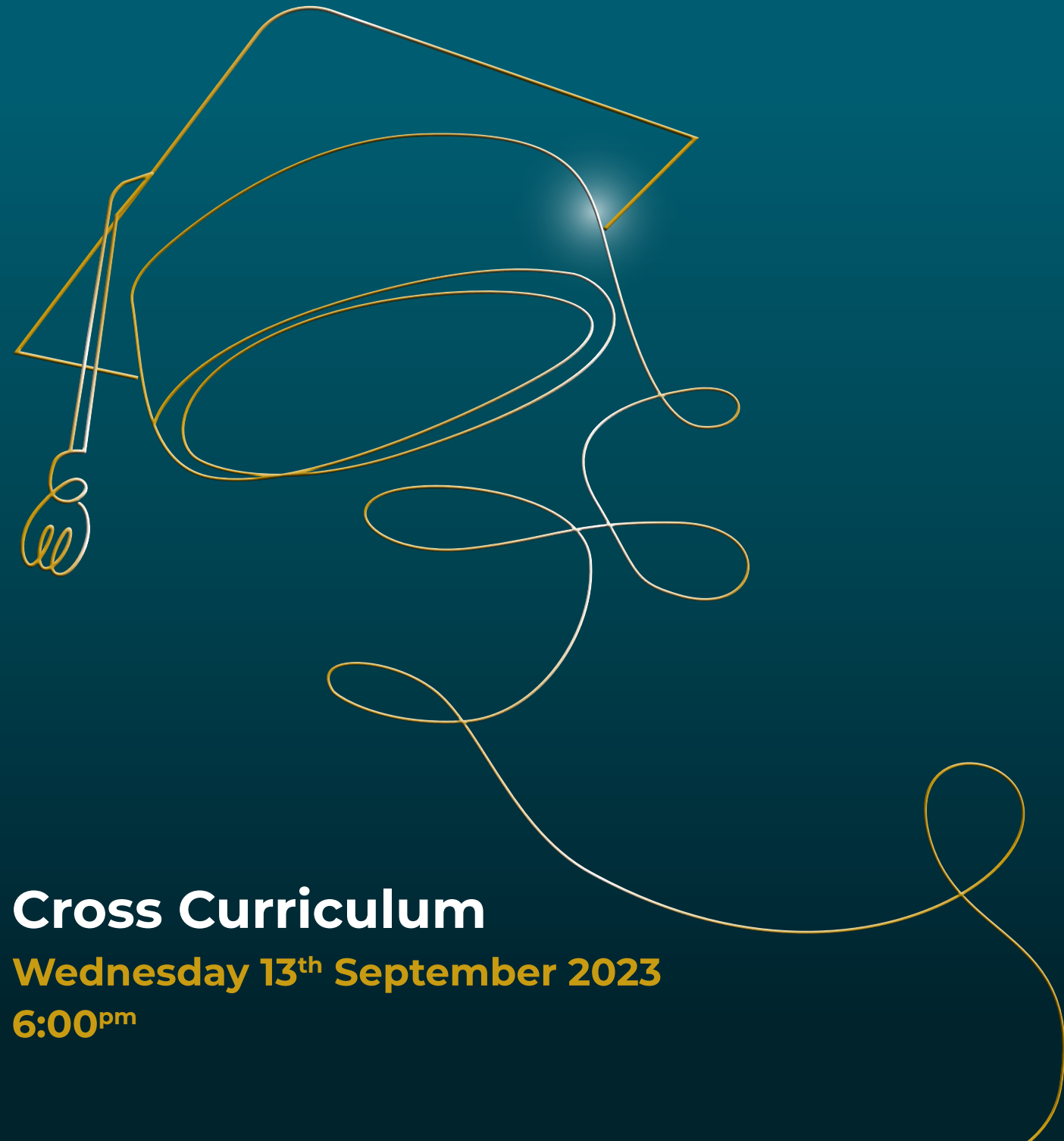
Today we are celebrating the life and achievements of our student, Kelsey Walsh, who was tragically taken away from us in January.
